FAQ

What type of face paint do you use?

All of our face paints used are FDA approved and cosmetic grade paint that is made specifically for use on the skin. We use the [Snazaroo](#) and [Blue Squid](#) brand of face paints exclusively.

How many faces can you paint in one hour?

This will depend on the design. Complicated or full face paintings take longer than cheek art. Typically each artist can paint approximately 10 detailed designs per hour.

How do you remove the face paint?

Warm soapy water or baby wipes will remove the face paint.

How do you keep your paint and brushes sanitized?

Unlike regular makeup, which is designed to be used by a single person, face paint is designed to be used by multiple people therefore professional face paints contain agents which act against yeast, mold and bacteria.

Our paints, brushes and sponges are washed and soaked in alcohol after each event. Express Yourself Studios follows strict hygiene practices to ensure the safest painting experience.

How old do you have to be to get face painted?

We will only face paint children who are 2-years of age or older.

Can I request a custom design or specific theme?

Absolutely please provide samples of your intended design in advance.

Is Gratuity included?

Gratuity is not included in the face painting fee. While tipping is customary and appreciated for the face painters, it is at the sole discretion of the customer. For those who choose to tip a 10% - 20% gratuity is suggested.
